- Portfolio details **The Coach's Workbook contains a concise description of the course as well as a 'Tool Kit' section with readily applicable aids. Coaches are prompted to add their own 'tools'**
- Coach observation details **Succinct checklist style which directly links with outcomes and criteria. A 'natural progression is evident.**
