Training Description:

One day workshop consisting of approximately 8 hours excluding breaks.

Critical Path includes Six Steps: Participants and Sport Needs, the Rules and Equipment of Touch Football, Ethical Decision-Making, Fundamental Flag Football Skills, Practice Planning and Safety, and Practice Coaching.

Activities include videos, mini-lectures, small group activities, pair tasks, Big Coach/Little Coach activities and demonstration practices.
