The CSI program is an integrated delivery format based on the NCCP Community Sport Template.

### Training Description:

- Workshop description (duration, logistics) 10-12 hours (8-10 classroom, 2 on ice)
- The two practice coach sessions allow for Assessment by the LF as well as Peer observation and feedback.
- Innovative approach a portion of classroom and on ice activity involves skill teaching & learning from the facilitator.

### Learning Facilitator training:

- 20 hours workshop hosted by Ringette Canada for Master Learning Facilitators
- National implementation: Ringette Canada sets the guidelines with MLF Training and Evaluation Procedures. National MLFs train the Provincial LFs and Evaluators.
