Training Description:

The Golf Coach-NC workshop involves three consecutive days of training which focus on the outcomes required to work with golfers who are learning to cope with the physical and mental challenges of competition. The workshop covers practice planning, teaching, player analysis, optimizing competitive experiences, and participant tracking. Throughout the three days the coaches are assessed and receive feedback from the Learning Facilitator. Upon successful conclusion of this workshop, the coach is NCCP Trained as a Golf Coach New Competitors. Workshops are available across the country through the provincial/territorial golf associations.

Evaluation Description:

To receive a certified status in this context, the coaches must develop a portfolio that includes: a profile of the coach candidate, an emergency action plan, three written session plan, sample analysis reports, completed program plan workbook, player progress reports, and feedback forms. Once the portfolio has been submitted to the Canadian PGA office, the candidate is then evaluated by a Canadian PGA Evaluator while coaching a lesson with new competitors. Successful completion of the portfolio and the video observation provides the coach with a NCCP Certified status.

Learning Facilitator & Evaluator Training:

- Learning Facilitators and Evaluators are trained through the Canadian PGA LF/Evaluator training workshop based on the NCCP LF and Evaluator training processes.
