Description of Facial Expressions

(Under the face you would ask the participants to write down some point form comments to support their picture)

Description of Text Message

- **When you are facilitating, ask your participants to write one sentence to summarize the topic being discussed.**

CAT #5 **Airplane**

Description of Airplane
